

Fitting the Steel H&R Trigger Guard

H&R has been out-of-stock on the all steel trigger guards for a while now, but when they do get some in...

The part is non-returnable, so if you put it in yourself, be careful. If you're interested the part number is: RO2513 - steel trigger guard - \$39.95 + \$5.00 s/h. Note: That was the price when I last bought one, in 2005, they may be more expensive now.

When you call H&R 1871 for ordering, they will tell you on the front end that this part may require fitting and they prefer selling it only to gunsmiths and so on... (they will sell it though).

In the picture to the right, the part at the top is the steel one, and the bottom one is the standard plastic. I've fit three of the steel type to various guns, and the white lines show where I had to file mine a bit to fit. The barrel catch barely rubbed on these points. A few strokes of a file did it though, then a little cold blue.

They also have a steel forearm spacer, but you would have to ask H&R for that part number and price.
