

# The Mossberg 500 Washer Tip

There's often a pretty large gap between the front of the magtube and the barrel lug/nut on Mossberg 500's, even with the barrel fully seated. Especially when shooting a slug barrel, put a 7/16" washer between the tube and lug (spray paint to match finish). If there is enough gap for the barrel to fully seat, then this will make the torque you use to snug the nut down MUCH more consistent. My son's slug groups tightened up about 1.5" at 100 yards doing this...

It will also raise the point of impact a tad with shotshells on some guns. **MAKE SURE** that the barrel will fully seat into the receiver when you try a washer on your gun. If it won't, don't use the washer.
